### SUBMISSION OF ADS

High-resolution Digital Media, Electronic transfer or CD-ROM

### REQUIRED FORMAT

PDF / Acrobat 5 or higher; EPS or TIFF

Laser proof must accompany all digital file submissions. Ads must be complete and sized at 100%. Ad size needs to include necessary bleeds (minimum bleed allowance = 1/8" each side). All fonts and graphics must be embedded. Ads must be saved as high resolution for print publication (600 dpi for images containing pictures and text, 1200 dpi for black and white text). Four color solids should not exceed SWOP density of 280%, maximum 300%. Convert all RGB to CMYK. Color ads must be accompanied by SWOP-certified proof (Chromalin/Matchprint, Kodak Approval Proof, IRIS, etc.)
